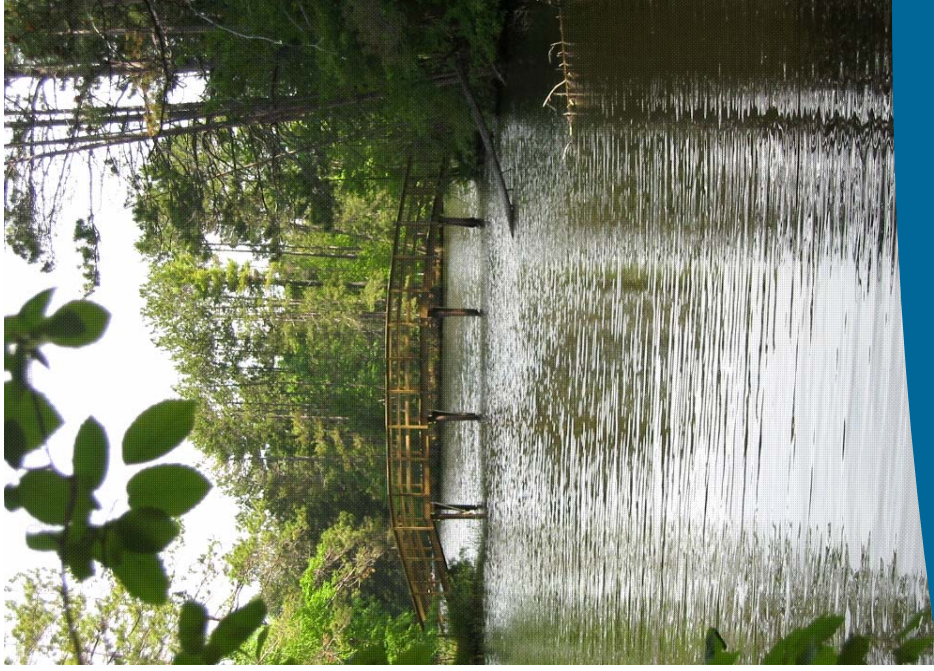

Funding Assistance

The STAR Foundation Board of Directors meets quarterly to review applications for funding. The average grant size is \$450. *The Foundation does not make contributions to individuals. 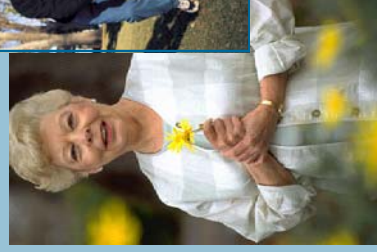
Making a Donation
